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What If...

After Opening

- What will you sell. The types of items you sell, such as electronics, pets, antiques, or used equipment, will affect which permits and licenses you need. Our Permit and Licenses page can help you determine which permits and licenses are necessary.
- **Sign Permit** If your business plans on using a sign, you will need a sign permit. This permit is required for most business signs and includes fabricated, hanging, and painted signs.
- Please avoid the use of plastic bags. Its best to use reusable bags, recycled paper bags, or compostable bags

- The Weights and Measures Licenses program registers weighing or measuring devices to ensure consumer protection and rights. Applies to any business that will be using regulated weighing and measuring devices. http://www.stamfordct.gov/environmental-health-inspections
- If you plan to hire employees, be sure to follow all wage and employment guidelines.
- If you plan on playing music over speakers, you must obtain a music license from at least one of the major music companies, like Broadcast Music, Inc. (BMI) or the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP). Retail store under 3,750 SQ FT that only play radio or TV broadcasts are exempt.
- If you want bike racks in front of your retail store, you must get a Street Use Permit on ViewPermit and have it reviewed by the Department of Engineering and be approved by the Department of Operations.

- Post all required posters and permits including No Smoking signs, minimum wage information, health inspection results, etc.
- Mark your calendar. Schedule equipment maintenance and set reminders to renew your permits and licenses as needed.
- Prepare and pay your local, state, and federal taxes.
